

NEEDED: Deputy Stage Manager/Show Caller (London/Frankfurt - Fixed Term)

The Stage Management team at The English Theatre Frankfurt is currently looking for a Deputy Stage Manager/Show Caller to support the Stage Management team for the rehearsal process and opening of *Something Rotten!* The contract would run from October 9th through November 27th and would include travel and a three week stay in Frankfurt, Germany.

Dates:

- London rehearsals: **October 9th through November 3rd** (Monday to Friday approximately 10:00 to 18:00).
- Frankfurt Technical rehearsals and the week after opening: **November 6th through November 27th** (travel to Frankfurt would take place on the weekend of November 4-5th)

Job Description:

- Assist the ETF Company Stage Manager to ensure the rehearsal periods run smoothly and that cast, creatives and other Stage Management team members are suitably supported.
- Be *on book* during rehearsals, keeping track of all script changes, cue points, line assignments, blocking, entrances and exits, costume changes, etc.
- Prepare the book during Technical rehearsals in order to call the show and deliver a detailed prompt copy with all cue points necessary.
- Call the first week of shows after opening (November 17th) while teaching/handing over the book to the in-house DSM after opening.
- Work collaboratively with all other departments, including the theatre technical team, to ensure the smooth running of the production.

Candidate Characteristics:

- Experience in calling musicals
- Strong communication skills, both verbal and written with excellent attention to detail
- A proactive and flexible attitude
- The ability to work well with actors and creative teams
- The ability to work under pressure and effectively prioritise
- Fluent in English (German knowledge not required)
- First-aid certification

Fee: 500€/week + *per diems* (while in Frankfurt)

Travel to and from Frankfurt will be provided as well as accommodation in Frankfurt..
